- Consider how chapter 1 & chapter 2 fit together. What overlapping themes can you spot? How does chapter 2 build on chapter 1?

## KEY TERMS\*

GODLINESS (vs. 2)

(Greek: *Eusebia*) Reverence, respect toward God that affects the way a person lives (See also 1 Tim. 3:16; 4:7-8; 6:3-6, 11)

MEDIATOR (vs. 5)

One who intervenes between two parties to restore peace or friendship; a reconciler. Christ, whose death intervened and restored harmony between God and man which sin had broken.

TRUTH (vs. 4, 7)

Objectively, what is true in any matter opposed to what is feigned or false. The truth as taught in the Christian religion, respecting God & the execution of his purposes through Christ & the duties of man. (See also 1 Tim. 3:15; 4:3; 6:5)

## KEY TERMS

- \*GODLINESS (vs. 10)

(Greek: *Theosebia*) Reverence toward God's goodness. A heart response to His work in the life of a believer.

- \*HAVE AUTHORITY (vs. 12)

To exercise dominion over one; to usurp authority or dominate. Used of one who acts on his/her own authority.

- \*\*QUIETLY / IN SILENCE (vs. 11,12)

Quietness, emphasizing the attitude or spirit in which women were to learn; a teachable spirit.

- \*CONTINUE (vs. 15)

To abide, dwell, or to persevere. Used of someone who cleaves or holds fast to a thing. (See also 2 Tim. 2:13; 3:14).
